Although the History plans are of a linear, chronological design, as it is a 4 year rolling programme to suit our vertically grouped KS2 class, not all children will receive teaching in this linear manner. To help the children put key historical events in a chronology a pictorial time line is displayed in the KS2 classroom. At the beginning of every history based topic references are made to the chronological time line.
