This planning for our mixed age class ensures that children study plants, animals including humans, seasonal changes and materials each year. Some blocks combine aspects of both the Year 1 and Year 2 curriculum whereas others are based on the curriculum content of a particular year group. In these cases activities are included to incorporate teaching at the level of year 2 children or adapted to be more accessible to the year 1 children. In each year, more difficult work is covered towards the end of the year to ensure progression for the children.
