Dear Parents

Welcome back to our final term of this year, we have started this term in a very busy way with visits to Badminton for the Year 2 Cluster event and to the farm. We really enjoyed both visits and our thanks go particularly to Hannah, Eli and family for welcoming us to their farm. We had a great time meeting the sheep, lambs and farm dogs; some of whom were keen to follow us back to school!

This term we will continue with our topic 'Far Away Places-Africa'; focusing on finding out more about life in Kenya itself. We will explore this in English, geography and science. Homework in term 6 will continue as in previous terms with weekly Maths and English and spellings or phonics tubs for Y1 and Y2. The children will have already brought home their first homework. Reception children will focus on their daily reading and phonics tubs.

As in previous terms the children in Y1 and Y2 will be learning a set of important mathematical facts which you will find included in your child's plastic wallets. Homework in term 6 will often support this learning.

Reading regularly at home continues to be an extremely important way to support your child at school.

I would also like to remind parents about remembering to bring water bottles to school and labelling uniform, both of these become even more important as the weather warms up. Also, our regular visits up to the Forest School will continue each Thursday so appropriate clothing needs to be brought into school each week.
