**RECEPTION LUNCHES** Reception children will be staying for lunch from this week. Please book your child's lunch online on ParentPay (bookings close at 8.30am each day) or send a packed lunch. You can book lunches ahead online for the whole week/month/term if you wish. ParentPay activation letters were sent home last week - if you have any problems please let the office know. If you have not already done so, please register any KS1 children for Universal Free School Meals with Gloucestershire County Council.

**SPORTS/CROSS COUNTRY RUNNING CLUB** The club will run on Friday afternoons starting next week and is for children in Years 3 - 6. Please see letter in wallets and return sign up slips by Wednesday 18th. There will be a charge of £12 for all six sessions up to half term.

**FLU IMMUNISATION Tuesday 8th October** This year the immunisation programme has been extended to include all year groups. You will find a letter and consent form in your wallet. **The form needs to be completed to consent or decline** and returned to the school office. There is no NHS online consent system this year due to problems they experienced with the system last year.

**WORLD MENTAL HEALTH DAY** We will be joining the Young Minds campaign to support young people's mental health by participating in the #HelloYellow fundraising - children should wear something yellow to school for a £1 donation on Friday 11th October.

**YEAR 6 SECONDARY TRANSFER** The admissions process for transfer to secondary schools is now open. If you live in Gloucestershire you will find a letter in your wallet with details of your unique reference number and how to access the Gloucestershire County Council online admissions system. **The deadline for applications is 31st October.** If you live in South Gloucestershire you will need to apply for a secondary place on the South Gloucestershire Council online portal which can be accessed at <https://www.southglos.gov.uk/education-and-learning/schools-and-education/school-admissions/apply-online-for-a-school-place/>

**KS2 HOMEWORK INFORMATION** Children in KS2 have been given homework folders and KIRFS. A copy of the homework letter is in KS2 parent wallets. Please remember to fill in your child's Reading Record whenever you hear them read at home. There will be weekly spelling tests for all KS2 children on Thursday mornings (starting 19th Sept) and Year 3/4 will have times tables tests on Friday mornings. Please help your child practice at home.

**COATS** Please make sure your child has a warm, waterproof coat with them everyday.

**PLASTIC WALLETS** Please remember to return your wallet **by Friday morning latest** each week. Wallets can be returned directly to the office or via your child's bag - please remind children to hand their wallet or any other correspondence in - staff cannot search through all the bags every day but they do give the children regular reminders!
