Hillesley Primary School understands and values the importance of physical activity and sport. The children are encouraged to undertake a range of sports and activities both within the Physical Education (PE) curriculum, at playtimes and also in extra-curricular activities. The Departments for Education, Health and Culture and Media and Sport have allocated ring-fenced funding to support the provision of PE and Sport in Schools.

PE funds are used to ensure all pupils receive a varied experience of sports and physical activities to instil enjoyment and increase levels of participation. Children's progress is monitored and tracked and all pupils have a good grounding in various sports and a knowledge of how to keep healthy, being well prepared for the move to KS3 where surveyed evidence indicates our pupils continue to take part in many sports with some going into higher levels, particularly in local and wider teams/events.

In the academic year 2020/21 we have planned to spend this money in the following way:

TA support	For those pupils who need extra support in order to access and fully take part in PE.
	For support with mixed-age classes in PE.
Staff training	Teachers and TAs training through discrete courses and by working alongside specialist coaches and providers.

<u>BOUGHT-IN SERVICES</u>	
Specialist Sports coaches and teachers	To provide both regular and one-off taster sessions of specialist sports and to run after school clubs to increase participation.* *Due to Covid regulations it will not be possible to have a variety of specialist outside providers visiting school for extra-curricular clubs and taster sessions.
<i>Intended Impact</i>	<i>Provide a wide experience of various sports and physical activity to increase interest and participation outside school and extra-curricular enrichment.*</i>
<u>IMPROVEMENT AND EXPANSION OF PE SPACES (INDOOR AND OUTDOOR) AND EQUIPMENT</u>	
Outdoor	Improvement to safety, surfaces, markings.
Indoor	Improvement to safety and equipment (fixed and non-fixed)
Equipment	To complement training and provision of specialist sports, purchase of relevant equipment.

This would include payment to local sports co-ordinator and support at District Level.
