**Special Educational Needs and Disability Provision SEND**

**How do we identify and support children who may have additional and SEND?**

This is a small school with small classes and teaching groups. All pupils are regularly assessed and if a child is not making progress the reasons for this are examined closely, through our individual pupil profiles.

Extra support and intervention programmes can be used to support a child if he or she has additional needs.

As this is a small school the progress and support of every child is closely monitored and extra support is put in place wherever possible. An individual support plan is drawn up in consultation with the child's parents/carers. Regular meetings and reviews are held to monitor progress made.

If the school feels that there are additional needs that cannot be met within the school's current resources then specialist advice is sought from outside agencies such as the Advisory Teaching Service, Educational Psychologist, medical sector, Early Help, Inclusion, SEND support services.

*Covid-19 - due to the long period of lockdown and partial school closure, catch-up and intervention support programmes are being run in the key curriculum areas of Reading, Phonics and Maths. Thorough individual pupil assessments have been carried out to enable teaching staff to plan catch-up work that meets the needs of all pupils.*
