

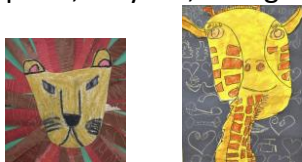
In addition to the weekly Class 1 homework

1. Art: Animal Picture

Make a picture of an animal you would find in Kenya e.g. elephant, lion, leopard. Think about how you could create your picture; paint, crayons, collage.



2. Maths: 2D shapes Tangram pictures

A tangram is a shape puzzle invented in China over 200 years ago. Cut out the tangram and see what animals you can create using all of the shapes. There is a tangram template on Google Classroom for you to print out.

What famous landmarks are there in Kenya?



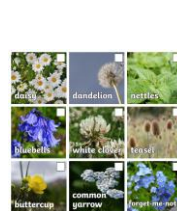
4. Science: Plants
