Special Educational Needs and Disability Provision (SEND)

How do we identify and support children who may have SEND?

This is a small school with small classes and teaching groups. All pupils are regularly assessed and, if a child is not making progress, the reasons for this are examined closely.

Extra support and intervention programmes can be used to support a child if he or she has additional needs.

As this is a small school, the progress and support of every child is closely monitored and extra support is put in place wherever possible. An individual support plan is drawn up in consultation with the child's parents/carers. Regular meetings and reviews are held to set targets and monitor progress made.

If the school feels that there are additional needs that cannot be met within the school's current resources then specialist advice is sought from outside agencies such as the Advisory Teaching Service, Educational Psychologist, medical sector, Early Help, Inclusion, SEND support services.

The SEND Statement will be monitored through the Governing Body.

The SEND Statement may be monitored by Ofsted during inspection processes.
