









'Pick and Mix' Homework

Choose at least two items to complete and bring into school for the 'Homework Celebration' event for children and parents on Tuesday 12th December from 2.30pm. Homework can be brought into school from Monday 11th December.

<p>1. Art: Famous Buildings</p> <p>Find a picture (or visit) a famous building. Reproduce the building in any way you like. You could draw or paint. Try to use techniques learned in your art lessons! You could make a sculpture, or create a collage.</p> 	<p>2. DT: Ancient Greece</p> <p>Make an ancient Greek theatre mask. These masks were used by ancient Greek actors to create the faces of different characters in their performances. You could use cardboard, fabric, mod-roc or recycling materials to make a mask. You will need to decide what type of character you want to show... scary, happy, sad etc. Think about our work on recycled materials last year to help you join different materials using braces, flanges and different types of glue.</p> 
<p>3. Science:</p> <p>Can you make your own model of the key parts of the digestive system? It could be 2D or 3D and made from any materials you choose!</p> 	<p>4. History: research and report</p> <p>Research and produce a report about one of the great, groundbreaking Greek philosophers: Plato, Socrates or Aristotle. Remember to include how their achievements have changed our world and are still useful in today's society!</p> 
<p>6. Seasonal Cooking</p> <p>Make a delicious dish from seasonal fruits of your choice. Take a photograph of you making and eating it! If you like, you could bring in a sample to our homework celebration.</p> 	<p>5. English: Poetry Recital Competition</p> <p>Learn a poem by heart to recite during the last week of term 1 for our poetry recital competition!
